SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Who Can Submit: All are welcome to submit. All submissions must include clear takeaways, practical relevance, and connection to the WNY business context
- **Session Format:** Sessions are 50 minutes in length and can be led by one or more individuals
- **Submissions may include** one or multiple speakers, and selected presenters may be paired with others to form a session
- Audience Engagement: Successful submissions will prioritize audience interaction and engagement
- Content Level: Content can be targeted at those beginning their sustainable business journey or those with advanced experience and knowledge
- Speaker Benefit: 2025 Summit speakers will receive member ticket pricing
- Submission Deadline: Submissions are due by August 1, 2025
- **Review Process:** Submissions will be reviewed on a rolling basis. You may receive follow-up questions or a request to connect before the deadline
- **Notification Date:** Applicants will be notified of the selection decision during the week of August 18

ABSTRCT SUBMISSION

- Location: Where you will be traveling from
- Session working title or key topic areas
- 300-word abstract outlining:
 - The session's objectives and how it aligns with the Summit's theme
 - A clear session goal and key takeaways for the audience
 - Any planned audience interaction or participation
- Has this topic been presented before? If yes, please note where and to whom
- Target audience: Who will benefit most from this session?
- Suggested audience knowledge level: Beginner, intermediate, or advanced
- Technology needs: Any tools or tech required to deliver the session
